If a crash happens before that point it should count as part of the race, by a strict reading of the rules. Then, there is the "human eye" aspect of the race jury which by strict interpretation of the rules can apply all rules as they see fit. They decided to pretend 3km is actually 3.5km in this case, case closed.









