

BusterSci I've been making baguettes for close to a decade. The water pan also keeps the exterior moist longer, allowing for a more vigorous oven spring. I suggest you try either a large baking stone or steel, or a cookie sheet. And I can't see that you slashed them--also important for oven spring.

**BusterSci** Some people say to spray the sides of the oven to get more 07-14-2025 steam, but they don't understand that does nothing but cool the oven off. I've had some luck with misting the loaf 3 times at 30s intervals. Again, facilitates oven spring and crisps the crust.

**BusterSci** If you're a purist, the recipe is flour, water, salt and yeast, at 07-14-2025 about 75-80% hydration (that's baker's percentage.) A lot of people add diastatic malt and other things because they feel it makes a better crust or improves the rise or whatever. If you're a purist, that's an abomination. If you just want the best easy loaf without getting nutty about it, go right ahead and add stuff.

**BusterSci** The old Baking with Julia book has a neat recipe that uses a <sup>07-14-2025</sup> nugget of dough from the prior batch to start then next batch. It isn't a sourdough because you don't let it go that long. But it does add flavor. Another key is LONG fermentation. You want to get those alcohols to add flavor. It's a two day process with an overnight slow ferment in the fridge.




