Joanna in New York There are two categorized climbs on the stage, both Cat. 4. The first, Côte de Saint-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse, comes at 34km and is a 1.3km climb at 6.1%. The second, Côte de Châteaufort, comes at 38km and is 900m at 4.9%. It is doubtful that these climbs will have any impact in the overall KOM standings. The sprint comes on the third circuit of the Champs at km 89.5.
