Tim in KY There are two Cat 3s, two Cat 2s and three Cat 1s. The road tips up after just 18 kilometers of riding and is all up or down after that. Even the intermediate sprint is after the start of the first climb. There are bonus seconds for the first three riders over the penultimate climb. The finish is uphill at the ski station at La Planche des Belles Filles. This is the fourth time the race has finished here since it was introduced in 2012, but it's a bit different this time. 1100 meters have been added to the climb, the first 1000 are unpaved, the last 100 are paved but go up at 24%.




