



Tim in KY TdF Stage 8 is 200 kilometers from Mâcon in Burgundy to Saint-Étienne in the Loire valley. The route heads generally south along the western edge of the Saône and Rhône valleys but gradually moves a bit west into the Loire valley.

There are bonus seconds available on the final climb, which crests 12 km from the finish. The betting is that this is too much for the sprinters and unworthy of GC attention so the break will stay away. Which would mean a big fight and a big break.
