





04-Sep-2019 **Tim in KY** The stage starts with a short uncategorized climb and the 15:33:23 proceeds along a plateau for 100 kilometers with a Cat 3 in the middle. The route then descends 400 meters to a false flat for 25 km. The final 40 kilometers include three Cat 3 climbs, the last of which crests just 8 km from the finish. Although the stage is classified as "flat", it is not a day for the sprinters.
