The second 1500 meters averages only 3.2% and actually flattens for the last 500 meters. Should make for an "interesting" sprint.

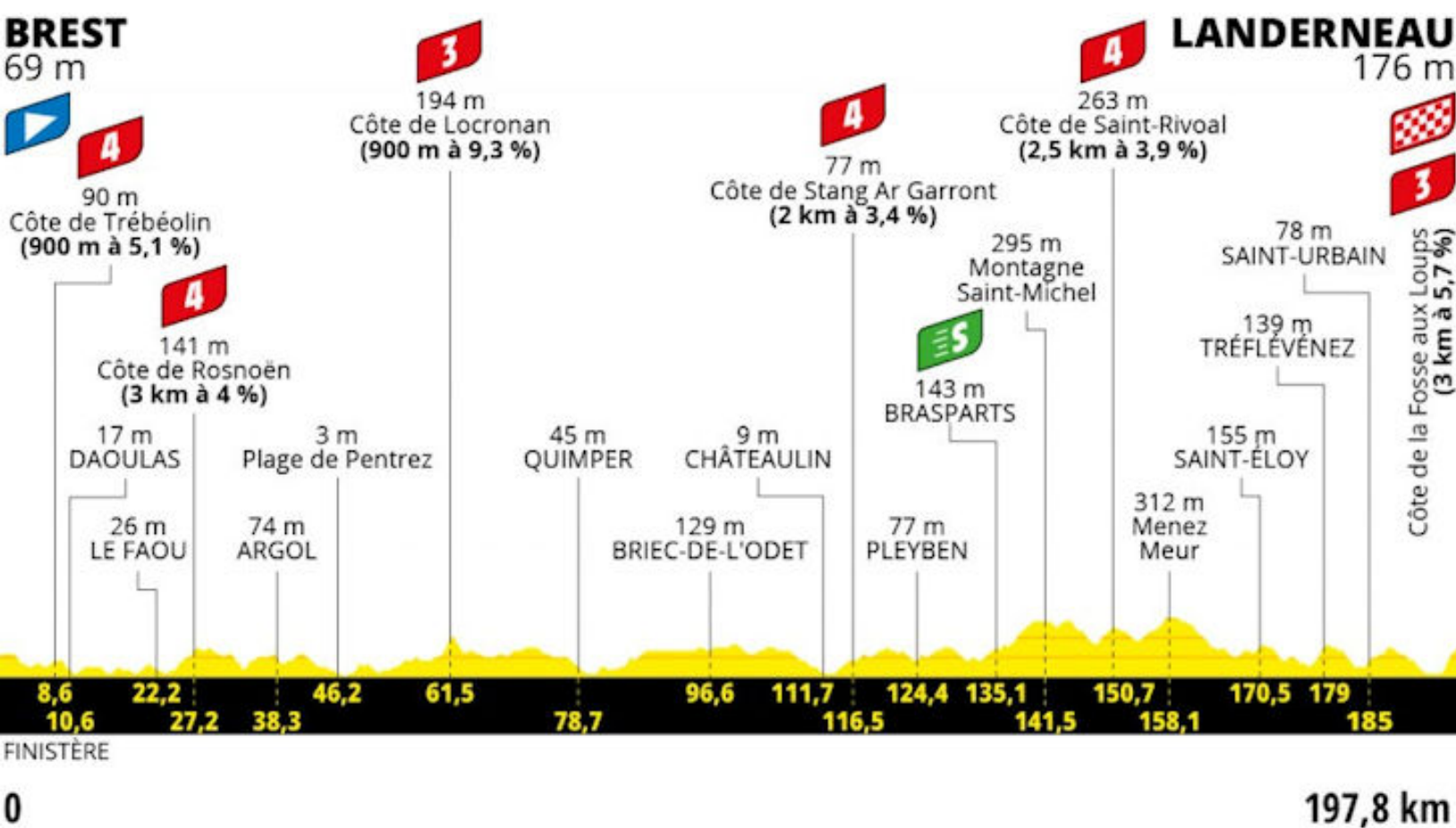

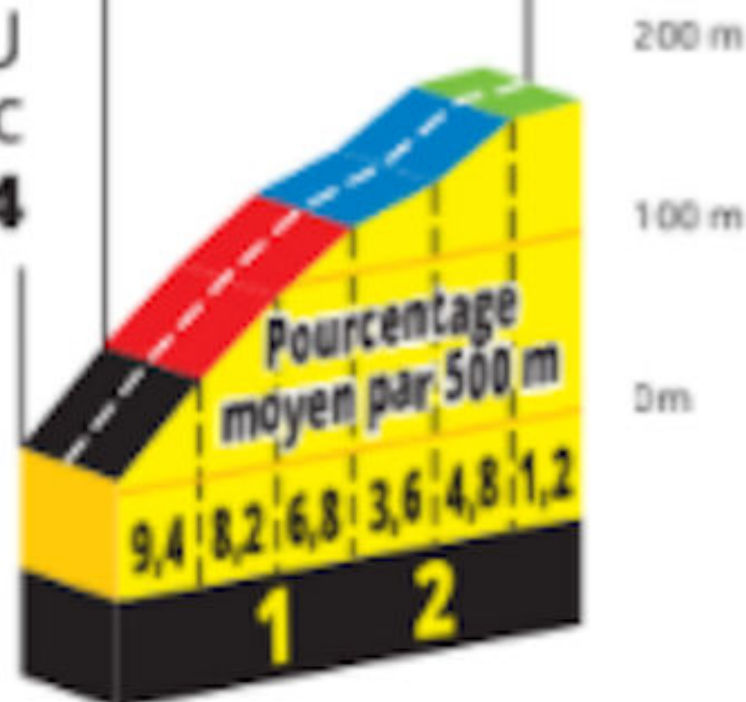

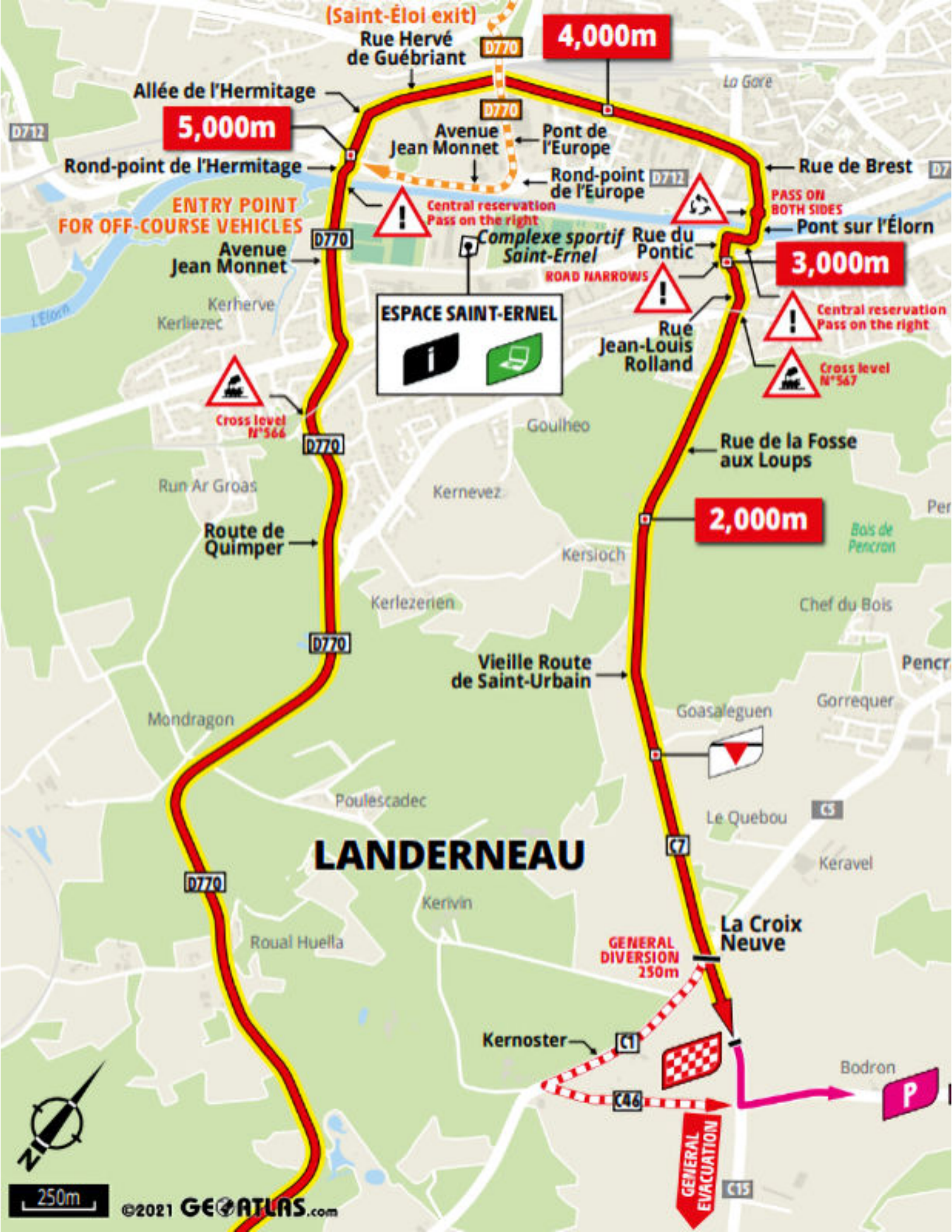

Well made muscadet has a saline note. It tastes of the sea. And the best part? If you can find it, it's CHEAP, and should be available at TotalWine. A lot of people say it's similar to a good lager if you're more familiar with the beer world. You'll often see "sur lie" on the label, meaning it's bottled without filtering out the dead yeast. This adds complexity to what is normally a simple, straightforward wine. If you're having shrimp, mussels, oysters or clams, try a bottle.
