Katie Lane This is a full mountain stage. The route climbs the Passo della Crosetta (11 km, 7% gradient), reaching the Cansiglio, and then descends or

undulates, twisting continuously, through the Piave valley, all the way to Pieve di Cadore. The race enters the Boite valley and climbs the Forcella Cibiana (9.6 km, 8% gradient), then enters the Val di Zoldo for the closing ascent. Final kilometres The last 15 km in the Val di Zoldo feature two categorized climbs. Coi, the first one, has uphill gradients of nearly 20%; the roadway is narrowed at points, but well paved. The finish is 5 km from the summit. A short descent leads into the final 3 km, with gradients hovering around 6%. Eight consecutive switchbacks lead into the home straight (300 m long and 7 m wide).



Katie Lane After a fairly flat start, the riders will ascend The Passo Della Crosetta, which is 11.6 km long with an average gradient a little over 7% and ramps as steep as 11%.Â The summit is 40.8 km into the race.

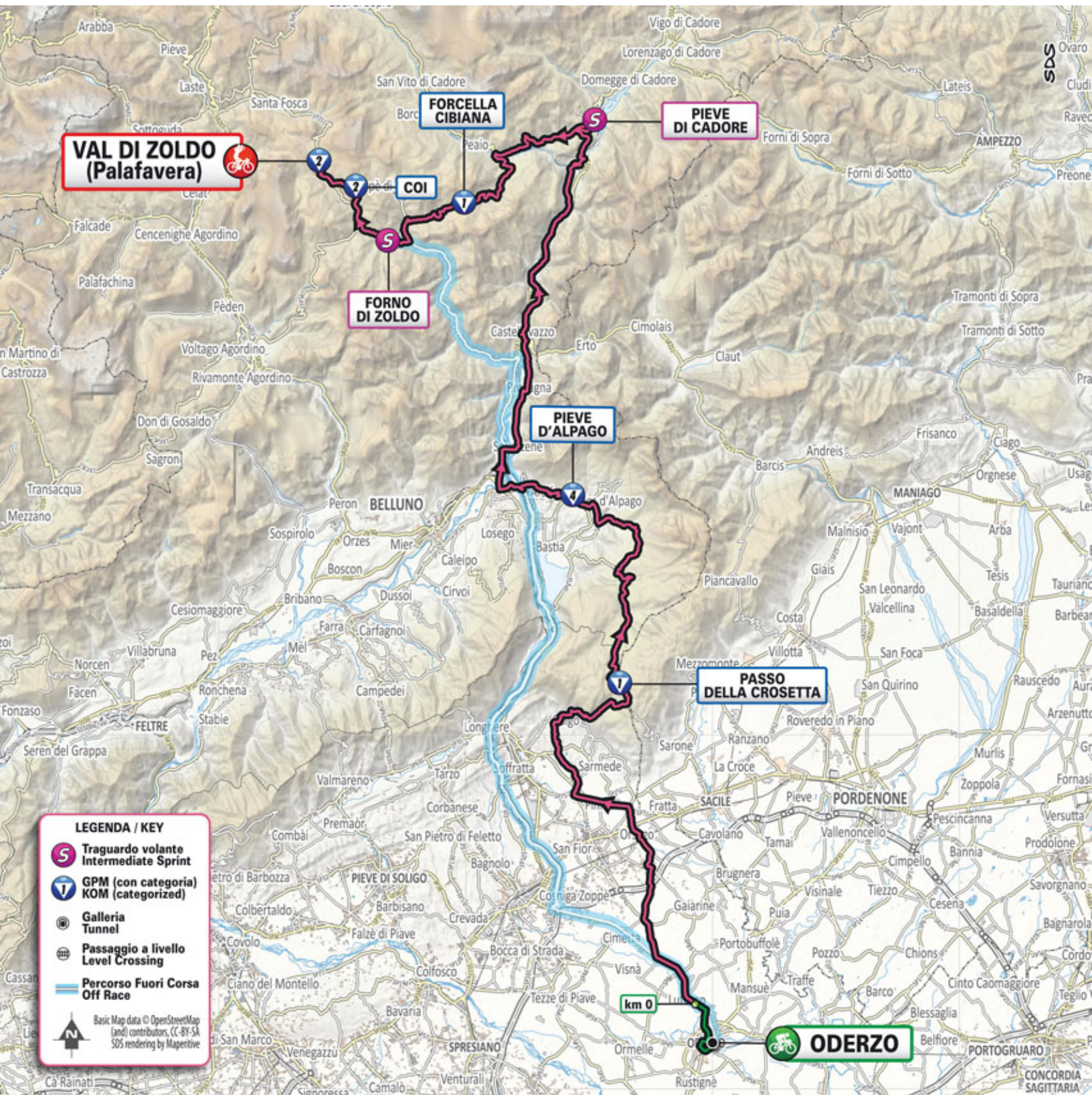

Rocket City Gal The route then mostly descends for a bit before the category 4 Pieve d' Alpago, which crests 68.3 km into the route. Then there is a long gradual and then steeper uphill before the first sprint at 115.7 km, then things are again relatively flat before the 9.6 km climb of Category 1 Forcella Cibiana, which actually starts with a bit of a descent before the ascending begins; the average gradient is 7.8%, but there are ramps of up to 15%. The 2nd half of the climb is much steeper than the first half. This climb crests 135.2 km into the race.

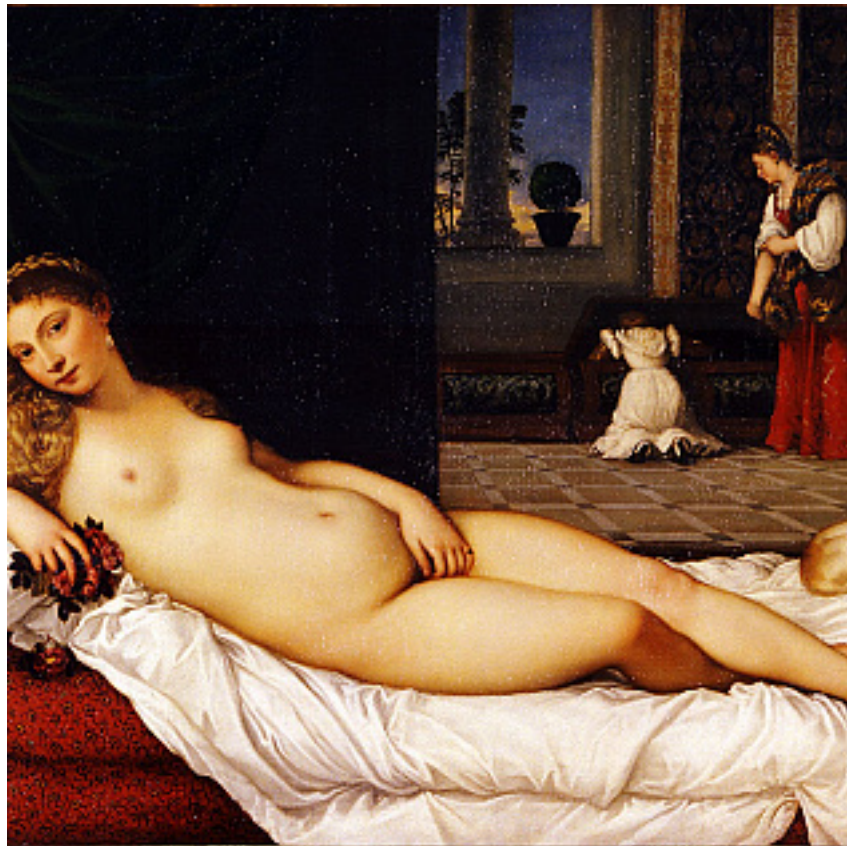
