BusterSci Eyeballs. Â I had vitrectomy in both eyes. Â 5 days for the bubble 07-20-2023 to dissolve. Â Very weird. Â But at least that's a planned and controlled situation. Â Don't want to deal with retina tear.

Katie S you did! I'm very curious, Buster, about that procedure. My brother has developed a massive floater in his right eye and is having trouble seeing. He has no vision in his left eye since a childhood car accident. The eye docs are loathe to try a vitrectomy b/c of the risk to the only vision he has.

Katie Lane So in addition to spot welding the tear, he's spot welding around the entire edge of retina too, in 2 sessions, since l'm at super high risk of another tear or retinal detachment. If you're nearsighted your eyeball is long and the retinal's stretched out to begin with. Then if, as you get older if your posterior vitreous pulls away from the back of the eye, as often happens, there's even more tractionâ€!. A disaster waiting to happen.



BusterSci Vitrectomy takes about 25 minutes. Â You're conscious the whole 07-20-2023 time with the exception of about 30 seconds where they put you out in order to inject local anesthesia. they immobilize head and eye, so you're staring straight ahead and you see the needle come into your eye from the side. Â As the vitreous is replaced with saline there is a boundary layer that causes a reflections so you see the vessels of the retina in

exquisite detail. Â They leave a gas bubble to help pressure equalize and it slowly dissolves over about 5 days. Â Once can be weirded out by the gas bubble being at the bottom of the field of view, because the image on your retina is inverted, and then the brain flips it back over.


