No one would ever think of referring to miles, well, I would myself on occasion when I wanted to confuse the issue with Europeans. So, my bike computer measured kilometres in Europe. Since returning, and buying a new bike, I played around with the computer and switched, I think, to kilometers (whereas my computer on my bike at home has mph and kph indicators, the new computers don't seem to care about that). So, I think my bike here in Peru is now measuring in kilometers, I am not sure. I know my bike on Campbell's Island is measuring in KPH, because the tried and true computer is over 10 years old, and has a light.


