



Rocket City Gal Good morning. Welcome to the NUT Pub for another grueling stage in the French Alps. Stage 15 begins (Les Gets) and ends (Le Bettex) at ski resorts, although the race organizers have labeled the ending "Saint-Gervais-Mont-Blanc" (which is actually around 8 km before the finish line at Le Bettex). Mont Blanc is not just the highest peak in the Alps -- it is the highest in all of Western Europe. This is the final of the four mountaintop finishes in Le Tour this year (and, at 179 km, the longest mountain stage), and is the stage with the most climbing prior to the finishing climb.

Rocket City Gal The parcours starts with several uncategorized climbs that on any of the flatter / hilly stages would likely merit KOM points -- the Col des Fleuries (8.9 km / 4.6%), Aviernois (3.4 km / 4.4%) and Annency-le-Vieux (1.3 km / 6.1%), before the intermediate sprint in Bluffy (yes, even the sprint location has a craggy sort of a name, at least in English.) Then comes the first categorized climb of the day, the category one Col de la Forclaz de Montmin (7.2 km / 7.4% average grade, but with a long steep slog towards the top at up to 11%), a steep descent, and another uncategorized climb up Col du Marias (10.2 km / 3.2%) before ascending the category 1 Col de la Croix Fry (11.4 km / 7.1% average, 9.8% max).

 **Rocket City Gal** Then the climbers' legs can get some rest on the downhill, but remember that on the last visit to this area in 2016 drama unfolded, with the first 2 riders on GC --Froome and Mollema -- crashing on the wet descent, with Froome able to defend the yellow jersey but with Mollema affected enough that he slid down to 10th place. Climbing abilities will be very important on this stage, but good descenders could also pick up some time here.
