Tim in KY The profile is very lumpy with many small uncategorized climbs. The only categorized climbs come at the start of the stage.

Kilometer zero is the start of a 16.5-kilometer Cat 1 climb averaging 5.1%. 25 km later is the start of a 12 km Cat 2 averaging 4%. The rest of the stage is a gradual but lumpy descent of 500 vertical meters to a flat finish.






