

Mons Soseman Monte Gargano, along the Adriatic Coast, has been a place <sup>10-10-2020</sup> of pilgrimage since the 5th century of the Christian Era. It was there, during turbulent times, that the Archangel St. Michael was said to appear in the year 490. He warned of impending danger, of invading hordes, or possible other calamities. Within a few decades, in a war against the pagan (at the time) Neapolitans, he was said to have appeared at the top of this mountain, now called the Mountain of the Angel, and with a flaming sword helped the Pugliese repel the invading hordes and take the victory. Whilst already a place of pilgrimage, devotion to St. Michael increased substantially then, and devotional visits continued to grow through the centuries. When the Crusades reopened the sites in the Holy Land to Christians, they would often stop at Monte Gargano as their last devotional visit before setting sail. Monte Gargano is one of the three shrines dedicated to St. Michael in Europe. I would not infrequently greet people in Rome who started at Monte Gargano, stopped at the Castel Sant'Angelo in Rome, and were walking toward le Mont St. Michael in Northwest France...
