Como - Civiglio da semaforo

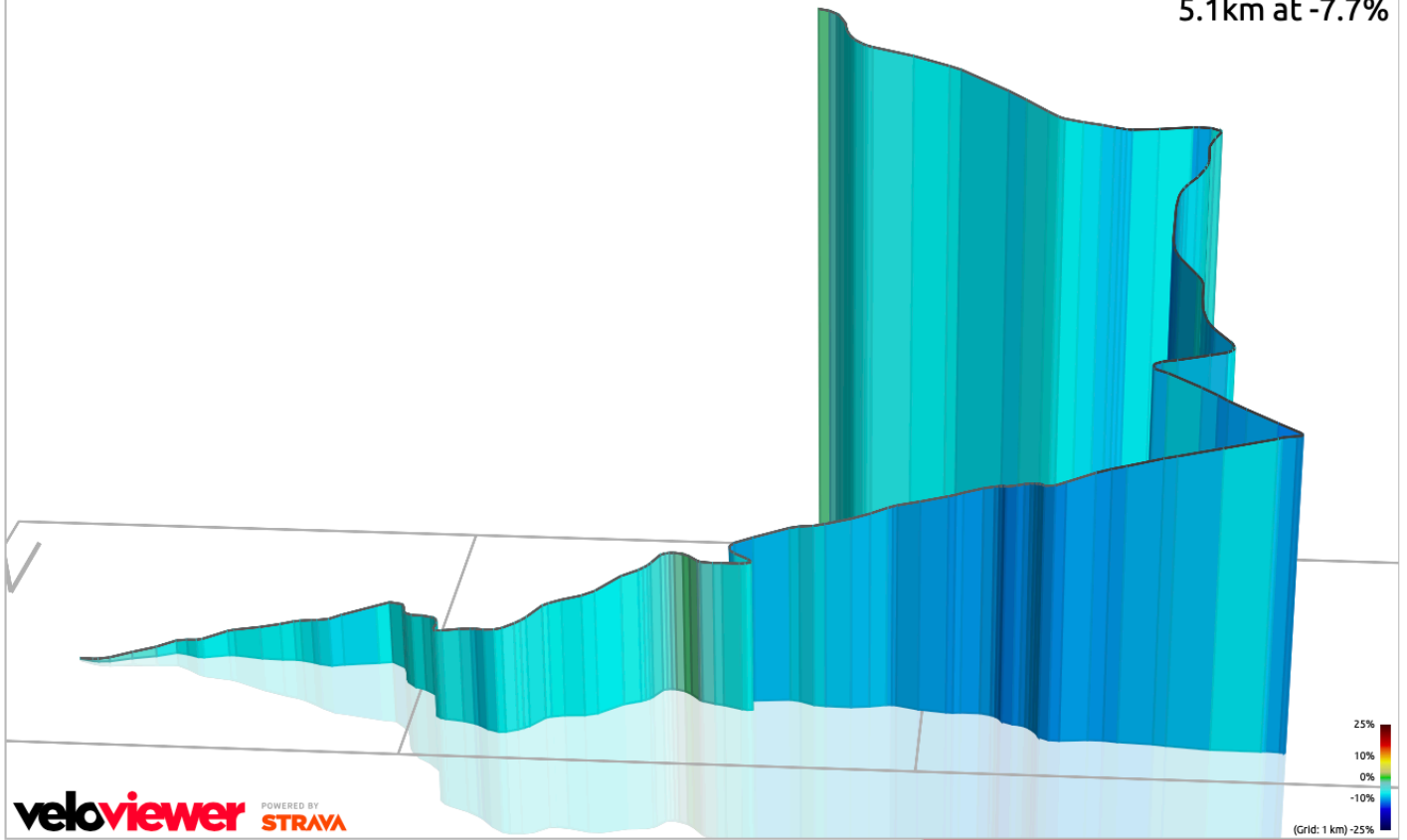


