
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


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San Candido, or Innichen if you prefer, is a mountain village proud of its heritage. There is much here to remind the casual observer of villages in Austria or Bavaria, even the architecture is more northern than southern. Many of the buildings date from the 12th century, but there is also a fun aqua park (called "Aquafun"), in case you are tired of touring. When it was founded in the high middle ages, the village was called "India." Local specialities include Canederli (again, those giant gnocchi or dumplings) here stuffed with speck ham, spinach, cheese, squash; Bauerngröstl, which is kind of a peasant stir fry, best translation I can do with the time I have; Beef Goulash, Schlutzkrapfen, which are croissants filled with ricotta cheese or spinach), and Pane pusterese, a local bread in large, round loaves, which is filled with hints of different spices, like fennel and cumin and coriander (sounds like the dough for Quad Cities Style Pizza, and if you don't know what that is, consult wikipedia... yum). Other specialities include Speck (a quite common dried ham), Kaiserschmarm (similar to a crêpe), Strauben, which comes to us as Funnel Cake (watch for it at a carnival near you. Who knew the origins?), and Apple Strudel.

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




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
