



Rocket City Gal Stage 9 of the Giro this year is 184 km in length, running from Cervia to Corno alle Scale. Cervia is fairly north in the “boot,” on the east (Adriatic) coast; as today’s route heads inland traveling more or less west, the riders will skirt just south of Bologna before hitting the mountains. Although the first part of the route is quite flat, today’s stage features 2,400 meters (7874 feet) of climbing... most of which comes in the final 28 km, with double-digit gradients in the last 3 km.

Rocket City Gal After the flat start, there is a 3.2 km uncategorized “bump” at 5.2% which starts at km 107. After that, things head gently but relentlessly uphill. When the riders reach Silla with 28 km remaining, they begin the 3.5 km, 7.2% climb to Gaggio Montano. The gradient then eases slightly, but on the stretch to Querciola they still must travel 11.3 km at an average of 4.3%
