Tim in KY There are five categorized climbs on this short course. The stage starts at the base of the Cat 1 Coll d'Ordino, officially 9 km at 5%, but

really much longer, it peaks 17 kilometers into the race. After a 27 km descent, the riders take on the HC Coll de la Gallina, 12.2 km at an average of 8%, but the first two km are very steep and there are double digit ramps scattered all the way up. Another long descent to the base of a Cat 2, followed, without a descent by another Cat 2. Again, there is no descent off the second, just the start of the Cat 1 finale, the Cortals d'Encamp, 5.7 km at 8.8%.
