Katie Lane Good morning and welcome to Stage 16 of the Giro d' Italia, which will be 203 miles from the scenic river valley town Sabio Chiese to Monte Bondone near Trento. The route, which has a 5 star difficulty rating, features 4 categorized climbs with 5200 meters of altitude gain. There are 17 tunnels along the route.

If the weather cooperates, we will see some stunning views on the video coverage.

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Katie Lane The first part of the stage runs along the shore of Lake Garda, ⁰⁵⁻²²⁻²⁰²³ with many tunnels of different lengths. Past Riva del Garda, the route takes in ^{07:20:27 am} a brace of climbs accumulating over 5,000 m in vertical elevation. Riders will take on the Passo di Santa Barbara (12 km, avg. gradient over 8%) and the Passo di Bordala (4.5 km around 7%), entering the Adige Valley and, past Rovereto, the Vallarsa. After the consecutive ascents of Matassone (approx. 13 km at 5%) and Serrada (17 km at 5.5%), the route passes through Folgaria, heading back to the Adige. Last comes the climb to Monte Bondone from the Aldeno side (20 km, avg. gradient 6.8%, topping out at 15%). The roads are well paved and moderately wide. The final kilometres are slightly uphill (avg. gradient around 4%). The roadways are said to be in excellent condition, and the road becomes wider past Viote (around $\hat{a} \in 2$ km). The home straight (approx. 300 m) is on 7 m wide tarmac. (Reports of the road surface condition are from the Giro's official site. We shall see).

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

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

After a short descent, the riders will ascend the category 3 Passo Bordala, which is a much shorter climb but still with some cruel gradients of up to 12%.











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Katie Lane The riders will then plunge to Rovereto and cross the Adige ⁰⁵⁻²²⁻²⁰²³ river. I don't see a graphic for the Matassone on the Giro site, but the first 6 ^{07:45:56 am} km averages 8.4%; after a minor downhill, the last part of the ascent is less demanding.Â The climb is 11.4 km total, with and average gradient of 5.4%. The top of the Matassore comes 116.4 km into the race The route then descends again to the Adige valley, only for the riders to climb the category 2 Serrada which tops out at kilometer 153.5.

Katie Lane The riders will again plunge down to the Adige and follow the river upstream for a bit before turning towards Aldeno, in a 10 km flat section ⁰⁵⁻²²⁻²⁰²³ where they can mentally prepare for the grueling climb up the Bondone. The first 3 km is relatively steep at an average gradient of 9%, then the grade eases a bit before some steeper ramps. The steepest 15% section comes 5.5 km before the summit finish.



Katie Lane Monte Bondone was last climbed in the 2020 Giro, but was last ⁰⁵⁻²²⁻²⁰²³ used as a finish in 2006, where Ivan Basso attacked to solidify his Giro lead. ^{08:06:11 am} Its first famous (or infamous) inclusion in the Giro was in 1956 in a stage which was one of the most brutal in cycling history. That year, Charlie Gaul was in 24th place on GC, over a quarter of an hour behind the race leader with only 2 flat stages remaining in the race after







the Bondone stage. A blizzard hit, the temperature plummeted, and half of the peloton dropped out of the race including Gaul's great climbing rival Federico Bahamontes and raceleader Fornara. A Gaul excelled in miserable riding conditions; he dug deep into his suitcase of courage to gut out the climb. He won the stage by a wide margin which put him in the pink jersey and on the top step of the Giro podium that year.

In actuality there may be 17 sections of tunnel, because in some of the graphics for the stage it sure looks like more Most are along the lake in the flatter early portion of the race before the first climb.
