



SFinAus One more excerpt from the "Birth of the Yellow Jersey" by P. 19-Jul-2019 00:15:15 Bouvette and F. Galametz in Peloton Magazine No. 87 this month. Previously I copied the article's accounting of the L'Auto announcement of the idea for the yellow jersey 100 years ago on July 10. With what must have been the equivalent of Amazon Prime next day service in 1919, the first jersey was presented on July 19th. "The popular Eugene Christophe had been leading the race since the stage 4 finish in Le Sables-d'Olonne, and the Tour was in a short break in Grenoble prior to stage 11, when he received the very first yellow jersey. ... 'It was there that I received a beautiful package of six jerseys.'







SFinAus "On this occasion, eight lines within L' Auto's 'About the Race' 19-Jul-2019 column were given over to the episode: 'This morning, I handed over to the valiant Christophe a superb yellow jersey. You already know that our director [Desgrange puts himself centre stage] has decided that the man at the top of the general classification should wear a jersey in L' Auto's colors. The battle for the possession of the jersey is going to be passionate!' (Ask the WHF one hundred years later! - sfinaus) Without any great fuss, the presentation took place at the Cafe de l'Ascenseur in Grenoble's Cours Gambetta. It was from there that Christophe set out in the early morning of July 19, wearing the very first yellow jersey, to tackle the Grenoble-Geneva stage over the Galibier pass. "... Christophe said that none of the six jerseys he'd earned survived World War II. 'They fell apart during the war', he said. 'I used them as vests and simply wore them out. After all, back then, we didn't know what was going to happen.'"




