Federal agency cancels bullet train's grant of \$929 million

Trump administration offers state \$1 billion to erect barriers in ending partnership on \$79 billion project.

The Trump administration has canceled its \$929 million grant for the California High-Speed Rail project, a move that could end the partnership between the federal government and the state of California.

While loss of the money poses a potentially devastating blow to the project, state officials said the administration's decision to cancel the grant is not a final decision.

Termination of the 2009 grant was based on the state's alleged failure to meet certain conditions, including the state's failure to complete work for the project.
