I don't know <sup>13-May-2019</sup> the lifecycle costs of Lithium cells, but with NiMH batteries the question is more about the kind of pollution. If you think greenhouses gasses are more damaging the industrial waste, then it's likely a good tradeoff. Also, I question some of the assumptions in those studies, which have popped up with regularity for decades.


