Because the climbs offer only a total of 7 KOM points, Nielson Powless can take the day off and still keep his dots into stage 4. The second half of the stage is a bit lumpy but should allow for the sprinters to have their first go at a stage win. It will be an "interesting†bunch sprint with five roundabouts in the last 5 km and a 360Ű turn with 2 km to go.



Rocket City Gal There are tomatoes all over the front yard. A contractor ⁰⁷⁻⁰³⁻²⁰²³ ^{08:49:01 am} did some work and ran over and over and over the ground, compacting the soil ^{08:49:01 am} and rendering it devoid of life. 3 huge oak trees died last year as a result. I've been trying to rehab the soil by drilling fairly closely-spaced holes with an auger drill attachment, filling those holes with compost and peat most, and mulching over them with bark mulch. Well..... we worm compost (vermicompost) our non-meat/non-fat table scraps / veggie scrapings and such. Part of the compost I used for the hole-filling was worm compost. About 8-10 pretty healthy volunteer tomato plants came up in the area where I "drilled and filled," and we just left them there to see what would grow. It looks like they include yellow cherry tomatoes, either grape tomatoes on steroids or small Romas or a grape/Roma hybrid, and some pretty good-sized "regular" tomatoes. They look healthier than the pampered garden tomatoes!

Rocket City Gal I also planted some things that are varieties that develop ⁰⁷⁻⁰³⁻²⁰²³ long roots in the hopes that those will push through some of the clay. (Like ^{08:53:20 am} sunflowers, Daikon radishes that I'll snap the tops off of and leave to enrich the soil, and the like). It will take years to restore the microbiome and get worms to like the yard again. As an indicator of how bad it is, we dug a hole to plant a small dogwood tree and didn't come across a single worm.


