



the city of Zaragoza, Aragon. It is dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary under the title of Our Lady of the Pillar,[1] praised as "Mother of the Hispanic Peoples" by Pope John Paul II.[2][a] It is reputed to be the first-ever church dedicated to Mary.[3] Local traditions take the history of this basilica to the spread of Christianity in Roman Spain attributing to an apparition to Saint James the Great, the apostle who is believed by tradition to have brought Christianity to the country.[4] This is the only reported apparition of Mary to have occurred before her reputed Assumption.[2] Many of the kings of Spain, many other foreign rulers and saints have paid their devotion before this statue of Mary. Saint John of the Cross, Saint Teresa of Ávila, Saint Ignatius of Loyola, and Blessed William Joseph Chaminade are among the foremost ones.[5] The Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar is one of two minor basilicas in the city of Zaragoza, and is co-cathedral of the city alongside the nearby La Seo de Zaragoza. The architecture is of Baroque style, and the present building was predominantly built between 1681 and 1872.

white wine grapes where the grape skins are not removed but stay in contact with the
juice for days or even months, as is more typical with red wines.[2] This contrasts with
conventional white wine production, which involves crushing the grapes and quickly
moving the juice off the skins into the fermentation vessel. The skins contain color
pigment, phenols and tannins that would normally be considered undesirable for white
wines, while for red wines skin contact and maceration is a vital part of the
winemaking process that gives red wine its color, flavor, and texture.[3] Orange wines
tend to be natural (a.k.a. minimal intervention) wines. The International Organisation
of Vine and Wine describes orange/amber wine as "White wine with maceration" and
prescribes the minimum duration of the maceration phase to be 1 month.


